# 500,000 BULB FLOWERS PARK

The Call of the Flowering Mountain 2026 park event takes place approximately from May 13 to June 15, when the park bursts into a blaze of color with close to half a million blooming bulb flowers. The event attracts nearly 30,000 visitors, including many from abroad.
